We are hoping that everyone has a wonderful day and finds at least one treasure to brighten up their day. I look forward to seeing you all!

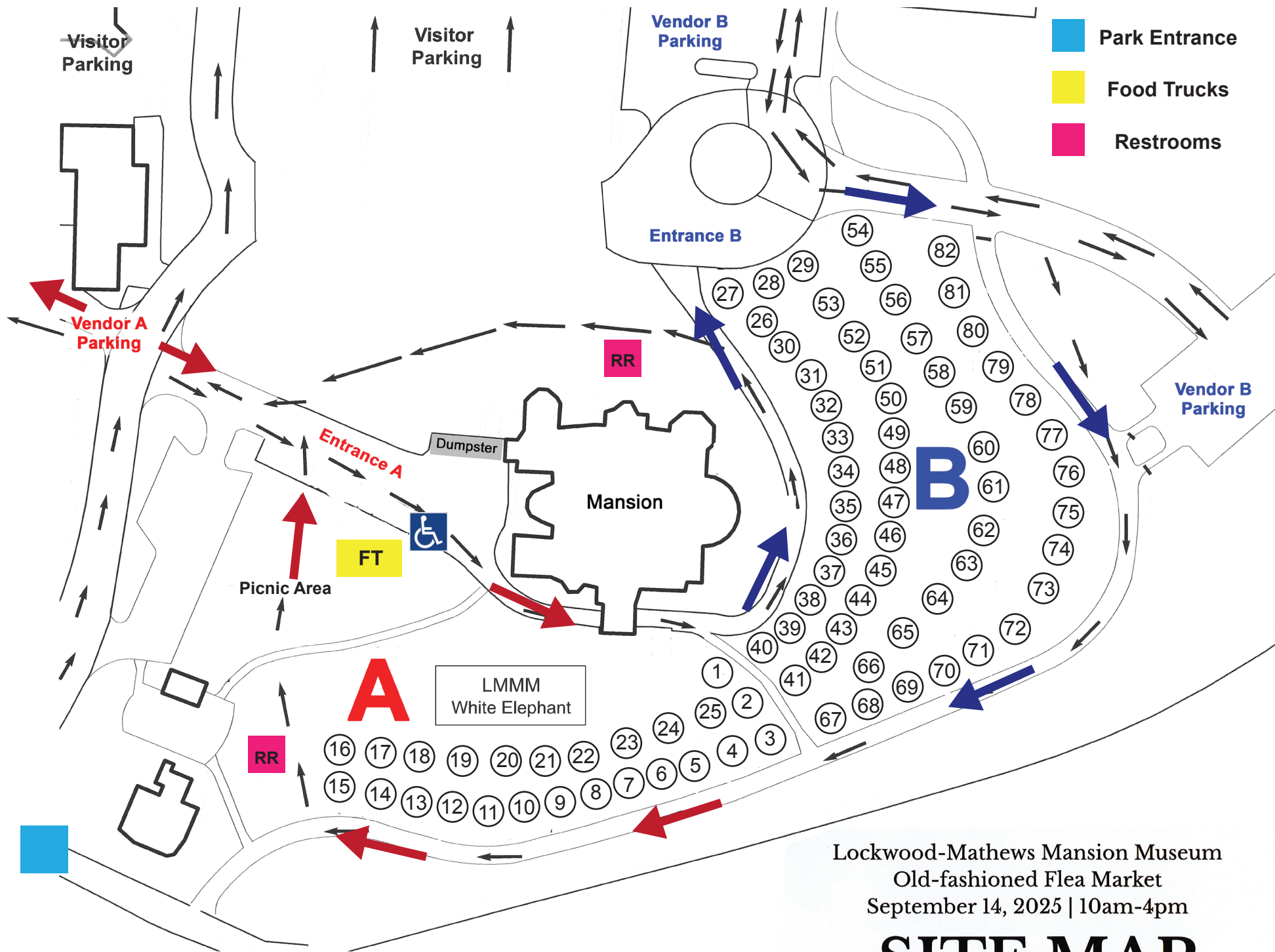

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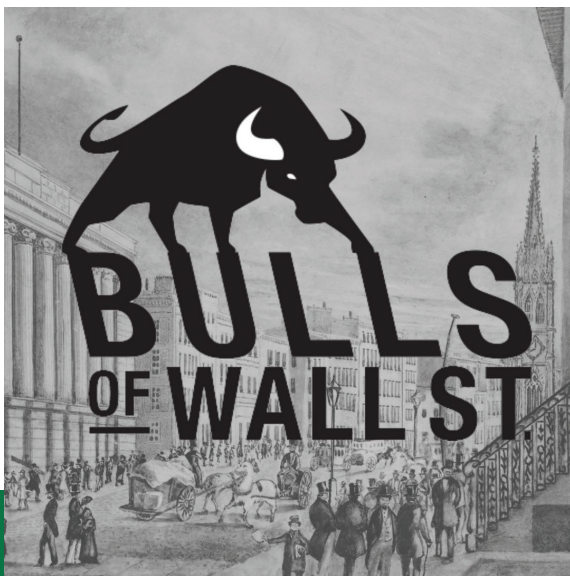
